






Case

 - Skeletal survey















Several research topics


- Screening Emergency room department

Cases Netherlands Forensic Institute 2010-2020

- Approximately 200 children, 0-4 years old
- 20%-30% deceased children
- Database Castor EDC
 - +-2000 variables









Primary objectives


- Dating brain injuries

- Presence of prior injuries and opportunities to diagnose child abuse
